

The ATHENA Award honors individuals who strive toward the highest levels of professional accomplishment: women who excel in their chosen field, have devoted time and energy to their community in a meaningful way and also open doors so that others may follow in their path.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Nominee must have a proven record of contribution to the business and/or financial growth of her company or organization.
- Nominee must demonstrate in her career ongoing advancement or progressive job growth, as well as significant leadership accomplishments and other achievements and milestones along the way.
- Nominee must possess a minimum of five years of professional business/non-profit experience.
- Nominee is not required to be a member of the Chamber or to be employed by a Chamber member firm. However, her employment must be within the Chamber service area encompassing the Greater Flagstaff area.
- Two nominees will be selected: one from the private sector, one from the non-profit sector.
- Previous ATHENA nominees are eligible for nomination.

EVALUATION CATEGORIES AND CRITERIA

Nominee will be evaluated according to the following categories:

- Exhibited active support for and involvement in the goals of professional women (beyond daily/regular job responsibilities).

SELECTION PROCESS

A Selection Committee consisting of a diverse group of leaders from the community will review all nomination forms and select the ATHENA recipient. The ATHENA Award Recipient will be announced at the Annual Meeting and Award Luncheon at the High Country Conference Center | Friday, February 21st, 2025.
